NCDEX – Warehouse status



**1. What does warehouse status mean?**

Warehouse status is maintained and updated by Authority – WDRA for the warehouses registered by WDRA under WDRA Act 2007.

Warehouse status is shared by WDRA to its repositories on daily basis.

**2. What are the various warehouse status that are maintained by WDRA?**

Active, Surrendered, Suspended, Cancelled, Expired and Inactive

**3. What are the impact on transactions based on the warehouse status?**

Matrix shown below denotes the impact on transactions based on the warehouse status, this matrix is applicable for both fresh & in-progress / in-transit transaction.
